Types of cases we may handle

- Bankruptcy, debt relief, consumer law
- Child custody, dependency issues
- Disaster legal aid (including Hurricane Ida)
- Domestic violence, Protection from Abuse orders
- Elder law
- Expungements, pardons, record sealing
- Government benefits issues
 - Unemployment compensation
 - SSI, SSDI
 - TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families)
 - SNAP (food stamps)
 - Medical assistance (Medicaid)
- Housing
 - Landlord-Tenant, eviction, habitability, public or subsidized housing, rent-to-own
 - Homeownership, mortgage foreclosure, property tax sales, reverse mortgages, tangled title
- Utility problems
- Veterans benefits, discharge upgrades

Who we can help

- Low-income individuals who meet financial eligibility guidelines. (In most cases, the upper limit for eligibility is 125% of the federal poverty level.)
- Low- and moderate-income older adults.
- Victims of domestic violence, regardless of income, to obtain a Protection from Abuse order and address other legal matters directly related to domestic violence.

We are not able to help*

- Undocumented immigrants (except for domestic violence cases and human trafficking cases).
- Defendants in Protection from Abuse cases.
- In criminal cases.
- In civil cases that don't meet our priority guidelines, such as personal injury, car accidents, traffic citations.
