Warden's Report

April 2020

Acting Warden Donna Mellon stated that the current inmate population is 989.

There are 901 males.

There are 88 females.

For the month of April there were 150 commitments and 443 discharges

The average daily population for April was 1,094.

Acting Warden Mellon reported that two inmates are waiting to be furloughed to Norristown. There is one additional inmate who has been deemed incompetent and will be attending the community ROC Program in Chester.

Due to COVID-19 transfers to Norristown State Hospital are still on hold.

In April there were 3 inmates who were restored to competency. One has been discharged and the other two are waiting for drug & alcohol evaluations.

Currently there is 33 inmates at Norristown on the forensic side. There are 16 inmates who cannot be resorted to competency.

Mr. Corson asked if programs are being held. Acting Warden Mellon stated that they are held remotely through paperwork.

There were 12 PREP I graduates.

There were 39 PREP II graduates.

Currently there are 6 inmates in the Vivitrol Program.

Mr. Corson suggested that program meetings be held via ZOOM. Ms. Mellon advised Mr. Corson that she would look into his suggestion.
