The Carpenters Joint Apprentice Committee's Standards are also registered in the states of Delaware and Maryland.



The Laborers'-AGC Education and Training Funds' National Apprenticeship Standards for the Construction Craft Laborer is 869.463.580. The O+Net Code is 47-2061.00.

The Laborers' District Council of Philadelphia and Vicinity Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee Apprenticeship Standards were registered by the Pennsylvania Apprenticeship and Training Council and the Federal Committee on Apprenticeship on January 8, 1998, the Program Registration # PA004970018.

This JATC registered its first Apprenticeship Class in November 2000 and had its first graduating class recorded September 2004. We have graduated apprentices to journeyperson status for each of the past 5 consecutive year. MEMORANDUM TO IMPLEMENT WAGE INCREASES AND EXTEND REMAINING TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN BRICKLAYERS AND ALLIED CRAFTWORKERS LOCAL 1 OF PA-DE

AND RESTORATION CONTRACTORS OF PHILADELPHIA

WHEREAS, the Restoration Contractors of Philadelphia ("Employer") has been bound to a collective bargaining agreement with the Bricklayers and Allied Craftworkers Local 1 of PA/DE ("Local 1"), which by its terms expires on April 30, 2020;

WHEREAS, the Employer previously agreed that it would continue to be bound by that collective bargaining agreement through April 30, 2021, would abide by all terms and conditions contained therein, and make certain increases to the wage rates of all employees (the "One-year Extension Agreement") which is hereby incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter a new, four-year Collective Bargaining Agreement, which includes additional increases to the wage rates of employees;

Local 1 and the below-signed Employer hereby state agree as follows:

- The above-noted parties to this Agreement have agreed to enter a new, four-year Collective Bargaining Agreement, the terms of which shall be effective from May 1,2021 through and including April 30, 2025.
- 2. All terms and conditions of the existing Collective Bargaining Agreement (which is scheduled to expire on April 30,2021) will remain in force and effect throughout the duration of this Agreement. The terms and conditions of the existing Collective Bargaining Agreement are hereby incorporated by reference.

3. Wage increases during the four-year term of this Agreement shall be as follows:

(a) Effective May 1,2021---\$1.30/Hour

(b) Effective May 1,2022-\$1.45/Hour

(c) Effective May 1,2023---\$1.55/Hour

(d) Effective May 1,2024---\$1.70/Hour

These increases shall be in addition to the increases previously implemented per the terms of the One -year Extension Agreement. The Union shall determine the manner in which these raises will be allocated and will give notice to all signatory employers as soon as possible regarding the allocation decisions. Wage sheets detailing the new wages and fringe benefit contributions will be distributed by the Local 1 to the signatory employers as soon as possible.
